In an effort to make the SMORS Industry Day as beneficial as possible to Industry and the Government, the SMORS team is postponing the first SMORS Industry Day from 15 March 2013 until July 2013. In the mean time, the SMORS team will continue entertaining one-on-one requests and subsequent meetings. Industry's feedback is crucial in executing the SMORS Multi-Award Indefinite Delivery / Indefinite Quantity strategy.

It's the Government's intent to post the overarching SMORS acquisition strategy information to include, but not limited to, contract period of performance/ordering period, contract ceiling, anticipated number of IDIQ contract awardees, small business participation, public-private partnership, and SMORS acquisition schedule to FedBizOpps.gov on or about 1 March 2013.

The July 2013 SMORS Industry Day event will be a two-day event held at Peterson AFB, Colorado Springs, Colorado, focusing on draft performance work statements, small business and public private partnership opportunities, and bidder's library documentation. Draft documents pertaining to the subject focus areas, as well as registration procedures will also be posted to FedBizOpps.gov prior to the July SMORS Industry Day.

The second Industry Day event will be scheduled for October 2013, also at Peterson AFB, Colorado Springs, Colorado, following the release of the draft Request for Proposal.

Lastly, the Space C2 and Surveillance Division (AFLCMC/HBQ) will have a booth at the Space Foundation's National Space Symposium being held 7-11 April 2013 at the Broadmoor Hotel, in Colorado Springs, Colorado. The AFLCMC/HBQ booth will have SMORS representation and prospective offerors for the SMORS acquisition will be able to schedule one-on-one meetings regarding the SMORS acquisition throughout the week of the Symposium.
